USING THIS LUKE JOURNAL:

A GUIDE FOR WEEKLY ENGAGEMENT

THIS JOURNAL IS DESIGNED TO ACCOMPANY OUR CHURCH-WIDE JOURNEY THROUGH THE GOSPEL OF LUKE. AS WE EXPLORE ONE CHAPTER TOGETHER DURING SERVICE AND IN SMALL GROUPS. THE GOAL IS NOT JUST TO LEARN ABOUT JESUS, BUT TO WALK WITH HIM MORE CLOSELY BY REFLECTING, RESPONDING, AND RECORDING WHAT HE'S DOING IN YOUR LIFE.

HOW TO USE IT:

1. READ THE SCRIPTURE BEFORE SUNDAY

• SET ASIDE TIME DURING THE WEEK TO READ THE CHAPTER THAT CORRESPONDS WITH SUNDAY'S TEACHING. ASK THE HOLY SPIRIT TO SPEAK TO YOU THROUGH THE PASSAGE.

2. BRING YOUR JOURNAL EVERY WEEK

 WHETHER YOU'RE IN SUNDAY SERVICE OR ON YOUR OWN, BRING YOUR JOURNAL WITH YOU. USE IT TO TAKE NOTES, JOT DOWN QUESTIONS, OR WRITE WHAT STANDS OUT DURING TEACHING.

3. ENGAGE WITH THE STUDY GUIDE

• EACH CHAPTER INCLUDES A SUMMARY, CORE INSIGHTS, A REFLECTION QUESTION, AND A QUOTE FROM A TRUSTED VOICE IN CHRISTIAN HISTORY. USE THESE TO SPARK DEEPER THOUGHT AND PERSONAL APPLICATION.

4. WRITE YOUR OWN REFLECTIONS

- AFTER EACH SECTION, LEAVE ROOM TO JOURNAL. ASK:
 - WHAT DID I LEARN ABOUT JESUS?
 - HOW DOES THIS CHALLENGE OR ENCOURAGE MY FAITH?
 - WHAT IS THE SPIRIT PROMPTING ME TO DO?

5. DISCUSS WITH OTHERS

 USE YOUR JOURNAL ENTRIES IN SMALL GROUP DISCUSSIONS OR CONVERSATIONS WITH FRIENDS. SHARE INSIGHTS, QUESTIONS, OR STRUGGLES HONESTLY—GROWTH HAPPENS IN COMMUNITY.

6. LOOK BACK AND CELEBRATE

• AS YOU GO, FLIP BACK THROUGH PREVIOUS ENTRIES TO SEE WHAT GOD HAS BEEN DOING IN YOUR HEART. LET THIS JOURNAL BECOME A TESTIMONY OF HIS WORK IN YOUR LIFE.

PROLOGUE TO THE

GOSPEL OF LUKE

THE GOSPEL OF LUKE IS ONE OF THE THREE SYNOPTIC GOSPELS, ALONGSIDE MATTHEW AND MARK, WHICH MEANS THEY PRESENT A SIMILAR STRUCTURE AND SEQUENCE IN RECOUNTING THE LIFE OF JESUS. WHAT SETS LUKE APART IS HIS METICULOUS ATTENTION TO HISTORICAL ACCURACY, NARRATIVE DETAIL, AND THEOLOGICAL PURPOSE. LUKE PRESENTS JESUS NOT ONLY AS THE LONG-AWAITED JEWISH MESSIAH, BUT ALSO AS THE SAVIOR FOR ALL HUMANITY.

THE BOOK IS WRITTEN BY **LUKE**, A PHYSICIAN AND CLOSE COMPANION OF THE APOSTLE PAUL. HE IS THE ONLY KNOWN GENTILE AUTHOR OF A NEW TESTAMENT BOOK, AND HIS WRITING REFLECTS A SCHOLARLY AND ORDERLY APPROACH. HIS GOSPEL IS ADDRESSED TO **THEOPHILUS**, A NAME THAT MEANS "LOVER OF GOD," LIKELY A HIGH-RANKING GENTILE INTERESTED IN LEARNING THE TRUTH ABOUT THE CHRISTIAN FAITH. LUKE STATES CLEARLY IN THE OPENING VERSES (LUKE 1:1–4) THAT HE COMPILED THIS ACCOUNT AFTER CAREFUL INVESTIGATION, RELYING ON EYEWITNESSES AND OTHER WRITTEN SOURCES, SO THAT THEOPHILUS MIGHT HAVE CERTAINTY REGARDING THE TEACHINGS HE HAD RECEIVED.

PROLOGUE TO THE

GOSPEL OF LUKE

ARE TWO VOLUMES OF A SINGLE WORK. TOGETHER, THEY TRACE THE FULL ARC OF GOD'S REDEMPTIVE PLAN, FROM THE INCARNATION OF CHRIST TO THE BIRTH AND SPREAD OF THE EARLY CHURCH. THE GOSPEL OF LUKE FOCUSES ON THE MINISTRY OF JESUS: HIS BIRTH, MIRACLES, PARABLES, TEACHINGS, CRUCIFIXION, AND RESURRECTION. THE BOOK OF ACTS, WRITTEN BY THE SAME AUTHOR TO THE SAME RECIPIENT, PICKS UP WHERE LUKE ENDS, DOCUMENTING THE ASCENSION OF JESUS AND THE EMPOWERING OF HIS FOLLOWERS BY THE HOLY SPIRIT. WHILE LUKE SHOWS US WHAT JESUS BEGAN TO DO AND TEACH, ACTS REVEALS WHAT HE CONTINUED TO DO THROUGH THE APOSTLES AND THE CHURCH BY HIS SPIRIT.

THEOLOGICALLY, THE GOSPEL OF LUKE PLACES STRONG EMPHASIS ON GOD'S FAITHFULNESS TO HIS PROMISES, THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, AND THE UNFOLDING PLAN OF SALVATION. LUKE TIES THE LIFE OF JESUS DIRECTLY TO THE FULFILLMENT OF OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECY AND LAYS THE FOUNDATION FOR UNDERSTANDING HOW THE GOSPEL WOULD EVENTUALLY GO FORTH TO THE NATIONS. HE CONSISTENTLY PRESENTS JESUS AS THE DIVINE SON OF MAN WHO CAME "TO SEEK AND SAVE THE LOST" (LUKE 19:10).

PROLOGUE TO THE

GOSPEL OF LUKE

LUKE'S GOSPEL IS NOT A COLLECTION OF RANDOM EVENTS—IT IS A PURPOSEFUL NARRATIVE DESIGNED TO SHOW THAT GOD'S PLAN IS UNFOLDING EXACTLY AS INTENDED, AND THAT JESUS IS AT THE CENTER OF IT ALL.

AS R.C. SPROUL ONCE SAID, "JESUS DIDN'T COME TO TELL US THE ANSWERS TO THE QUESTIONS OF LIFE. HE CAME TO BE THE ANSWER."

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

AS YOU OPEN THIS JOURNAL AND PREPARE TO WALK THROUGH THE GOSPEL OF LUKE, **TAKE A MOMENT TO PAUSE.** THIS ISN'T JUST A STUDY, IT'S AN INVITATION TO ENCOUNTER JESUS. LUKE CAREFULLY WROTE THIS ACCOUNT SO THAT WE MIGHT KNOW THE TRUTH ABOUT WHO JESUS IS AND WHAT HE HAS DONE (LUKE 1:4).

AS YOU JOURNEY THROUGH EACH CHAPTER, ALLOW SPACE FOR BOTH REFLECTION AND TRANSFORMATION. COME WITH AN OPEN HEART, READY TO BE CHALLENGED, COMFORTED, AND CHANGED.

BEFORE YOU TURN THE PAGE, TAKE A MOMENT TO WRITE A PRAYER. INVITE THE HOLY SPIRIT TO GUIDE YOUR TIME, SOFTEN YOUR HEART, AND REVEAL JESUS TO YOU IN FRESH WAYS. WHETHER IT'S A FEW WORDS OR A FULL PAGE, LET YOUR PRAYER BE THE STARTING POINT FOR THIS SACRED JOURNEY.

CHAPTER 1 LUKE PLAN

GOD BREAKS THE SILENCE

LUKE OPENS WITH DIVINE DISRUPTION: THE ANGEL GABRIEL VISITS ZECHARIAH DURING TEMPLE SERVICE, ANNOUNCING THE BIRTH OF JOHN, THE FORERUNNER WHO WILL PREPARE ISRAEL FOR THE LORD. THOUGH ZECHARIAH DOUBTS, GOD'S PROMISE STANDS. SIX MONTHS LATER, GABRIEL APPEARS AGAIN, THIS TIME TO MARY. UNLIKE ZECHARIAH, SHE RECEIVES THE **IMPOSSIBLE** WITH FAITH. MARY **VISITS** ELIZABETH, AND BOTH WOMEN EXPERIENCE SPIRIT-FILLED AFFIRMATION. WHEN JOHN IS BORN, ZECHARIAH PROPHESIES, DECLARING THAT GOD'S COVENANT PROMISES ARE COMING TO LIFE.

1. GOD USES FAITHFUL, OVERLOOKED PEOPLE

GOD'S PLAN UNFOLDS THROUGH HUMBLE, OBSCURE INDIVIDUALS LIKE ZECHARIAH, ELIZABETH, AND MARY, WHO WERE RIGHTEOUS BUT SOCIALLY INSIGNIFICANT (LUKE 1:5–38). THIS REFLECTS GOD'S PATTERN OF USING THE FAITHFUL, NOT THE PROMINENT, TO FULFILL HIS PURPOSES (1 CORINTHIANS 1:27).

- TRUST GOD CAN USE YOU DESPITE LIMITATIONS.
- ENCOURAGE OVERLOOKED INDIVIDUALS IN YOUR COMMUNITY.
- SUPPORT MINISTRIES FOR THE MARGINALIZED.

2. ZECHARIAH AND MARY'S CONTRASTING RESPONSES

ZECHARIAH DOUBTS GABRIEL'S ANNOUNCEMENT (LUKE 1:18), LEADING TO TEMPORARY SILENCE, WHILE MARY RESPONDS WITH FAITH AND SUBMISSION (LUKE 1:34, 38). THEIR RESPONSES SHOW GOD HONORS FAITH BUT WORKS DESPITE DOUBT.

- REFLECT ON YOUR RESPONSE TO GOD'S CALL
 FAITH OR SKEPTICISM?
- PRAY FOR MARY'S SUBMISSIVE FAITH IN DECISIONS.
- SEEK SUPPORT IF STRUGGLING WITH DOUBT.

3. JOHN FULFILLS MALACHI'S PROPHECY

JOHN THE BAPTIST'S BIRTH FULFILLS MALACHI 3:1, 4:5-6 AS THE PREPARER FOR THE MESSIAH, TURNING ISRAEL'S HEARTS TO GOD (LUKE 1:16-17).

- RECOGNIZE GOD'S TIMING IN FULFILLING PROMISES.
- PREPARE OTHERS FOR JESUS THROUGH EVANGELISM OR DISCIPLESHIP.
- STUDY OLD TESTAMENT PROPHECIES TO DEEPEN FAITH.

CHAPTER 1 LUKE PLAN

4. HOLY SPIRIT'S ACTIVE ROLE

THE SPIRIT FILLS ELIZABETH, ZECHARIAH, AND JOHN (LUKE 1:15, 41, 67) AND GUIDES MARY'S CONCEPTION (LUKE 1:35), SHOWING HIS WORK BEFORE PENTECOST.

- SEEK THE SPIRIT'S GUIDANCE IN PRAYER AND DECISIONS.
- TRUST THE SPIRIT'S WORK IN OTHERS, EVEN UNEXPECTEDLY.
- SHARE HOW THE SPIRIT HAS MOVED IN YOUR LIFE.

5. MARY'S SONG AND ZECHARIAH'S PROPHECY

MARY'S MAGNIFICAT (LUKE 1:46-55) AND ZECHARIAH'S BENEDICTUS (LUKE 1:68-79) FRAME JESUS' ARRIVAL AS COVENANT FULFILLMENT AND KINGDOM REVERSAL, EXALTING THE HUMBLE AND BRINGING SALVATION.

- PRAISE GOD FOR HIS FAITHFULNESS IN WORSHIP.
- ADVOCATE FOR JUSTICE, REFLECTING GOD'S KINGDOM VALUES.
- SHARE JESUS' TRANSFORMATIVE MESSAGE WITH OTHERS.

CHAPTER 2 LUKE PLAN

THE KINGDOM ARRIVES IN HUMILITY

JESUS IS BORN NOT IN GRANDEUR, BUT IN POVERTY, IN BETHLEHEM, JUST AS MICAH PROPHESIED. ANGELS ANNOUNCE HIS BIRTH NOT TO RULERS, BUT TO SHEPHERDS, REVEALING GOD'S HEART FOR THE LOWLY. AT THE TEMPLE, FAITHFUL PROPHETS SIMEON AND ANNA AS THE LONG-AWAITED RECOGNIZE HIM MESSIAH, DECLARING THAT SALVATION HAS COME FOR BOTH ISRAEL AND THE GENTILES. LATER, AT AGE TWELVE, JESUS SHOWS HIS AWARENESS OF HIS DIVINE IDENTITY, YET CHOOSES OBEDIENCE AND GROWTH.

1. JESUS' BIRTH FULFILLS PROPHECY, SUBVERTS EXPECTATIONS

JESUS' BIRTH IN BETHLEHEM FULFILLS MICAH 5:2, SIGNALING THE MESSIAH'S HUMBLE ARRIVAL (LUKE 2:1–7). BORN IN A MANGER, NOT A PALACE, HE DEFIES WORLDLY EXPECTATIONS OF POWER, REVEALING GOD'S KINGDOM PRIORITIZES HUMILITY OVER GRANDEUR.

- TRUST GOD'S UNCONVENTIONAL PLANS IN YOUR LIFE.
- SHARE THE GOSPEL'S MESSAGE OF HUMILITY WITH OTHERS.
- REFLECT ON HOW JESUS' HUMILITY CHALLENGES CULTURAL VALUES.

CHAPTER 2 LUKE PLAN

2. SHEPHERDS AS FIRST EVANGELISTS

SHEPHERDS, LOWLY IN STATUS, ARE THE FIRST TO HEAR AND PROCLAIM JESUS' BIRTH (LUKE 2:8–20). THEIR BOLD WITNESS SHOWS GOD CHOOSES THE HUMBLE TO SPREAD HIS MESSAGE.

- EMBRACE OPPORTUNITIES TO SHARE YOUR FAITH, REGARDLESS OF STATUS.
- ENCOURAGE OVERLOOKED INDIVIDUALS TO USE THEIR GIFTS FOR GOD'S GLORY.
- SUPPORT OUTREACH TO MARGINALIZED COMMUNITIES.

3. GOD REWARDS THOSE WHO WAIT

SIMEON AND ANNA, FAITHFUL AND PATIENT, RECEIVE SPIRITUAL VISION AND AFFIRMATION AT JESUS' PRESENTATION (LUKE 2:25–38). THEIR DEVOTION SHOWS GOD HONORS THOSE WHO TRUST HIS TIMING.

- PERSEVERE IN PRAYER AND TRUST GOD'S PROMISES.
- HONOR ELDERLY BELIEVERS FOR THEIR FAITHFULNESS.
- MENTOR OTHERS IN PATIENT ENDURANCE.

4. JESUS' YOUTHFUL DEVOTION

AT TWELVE, JESUS DISPLAYS WISDOM AND DEVOTION IN THE TEMPLE, YET SUBMITS TO HIS PARENTS (LUKE 2:41–52). HIS EXAMPLE HIGHLIGHTS SPIRITUAL MATURITY AND OBEDIENCE IN YOUTH.

- CULTIVATE SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES EARLY IN LIFE.
- ENCOURAGE YOUTH TO PURSUE WISDOM THROUGH SCRIPTURE.
- MODEL SUBMISSION TO GOD-GIVEN AUTHORITY.

CHAPTER 3 LUKE PLAN

PREPARING THE WAY FOR THE KING

JOHN THE BAPTIST EMERGES FROM THE WILDERNESS PROCLAIMING A BAPTISM OF REPENTANCE, ECHOING THE VOICE OF ISAIAH. CROWDS COME, AND HE CHALLENGES THEIR ASSUMPTIONS ABOUT RELIGION, REPENTANCE, AND FRUIT. JESUS APPEARS TO BE BAPTIZED, NOT BECAUSE HE NEEDS REPENTANCE, BUT TO IDENTIFY FULLY WITH HUMANITY. HEAVEN OPENS, THE SPIRIT DESCENDS, AND THE FATHER AFFIRMS HIS SON.

1. JOHN'S CALL FOR INTERNAL TRANSFORMATION

JOHN THE BAPTIST'S MESSAGE DEMANDS GENUINE REPENTANCE AND HEART CHANGE, NOT MERE RELIGIOUS RITUAL (LUKE 3:7–14). HE CONFRONTS HYPOCRISY, URGING FRUIT-BEARING LIVES OVER OUTWARD APPEARANCES.

- EXAMINE YOUR HEART FOR AUTHENTIC FAITH, NOT JUST RELIGIOUS HABITS.
- PRACTICE REPENTANCE THROUGH TANGIBLE ACTIONS LIKE GENEROSITY OR HONESTY.
- CHALLENGE OTHERS TO LIVE OUT FAITH SINCERELY.

CHAPTER 3 LUKE PLAN

2. BAPTISM MARKS JESUS' MISSION

JESUS' BAPTISM (LUKE 3:21–22) PUBLICLY INITIATES HIS MESSIANIC MISSION, AFFIRMED BY THE FATHER'S VOICE AND THE SPIRIT'S DESCENT, SIGNALING THE START OF HIS REDEMPTIVE WORK.

- VIEW YOUR COMMITMENTS (E.G., BAPTISM) AS A CALL TO ACTIVE FAITH.
- PUBLICLY AFFIRM YOUR FAITH THROUGH SERVICE OR TESTIMONY.
- ENCOURAGE NEW BELIEVERS TO EMBRACE THEIR CALLING.

3. TRINITY'S VISIBLE UNITY

AT JESUS' BAPTISM, THE FATHER SPEAKS, THE SON IS BAPTIZED, AND THE SPIRIT DESCENDS (LUKE 3:22), DISPLAYING THE TRINITY'S PERFECT UNITY AND AFFIRMING JESUS' DIVINE IDENTITY.

- WORSHIP THE TRIUNE GOD IN PRAYER AND STUDY.
- REFLECT TRINITARIAN UNITY IN COMMUNITY RELATIONSHIPS.
- TEACH OTHERS ABOUT THE TRINITY'S ROLE IN SALVATION.

CHAPTER 3 LUKE PLAN

4. JESUS' GENEALOGY: SAVIOR FOR ALL

LUKE'S GENEALOGY TRACES JESUS BACK TO ADAM (LUKE 3:23–38), SHOWING HE IS THE SAVIOR FOR ALL HUMANITY, NOT ONLY ISRAEL, FULFILLING GOD'S UNIVERSAL REDEMPTIVE PLAN.

- EMBRACE JESUS' INCLUSIVE SALVATION IN YOUR OUTREACH.
- STUDY SCRIPTURE TO UNDERSTAND GOD'S PLAN FOR ALL NATIONS.
- SHARE THE GOSPEL WITH DIVERSE COMMUNITIES.

CHAPTER 4 LUKE PLAN

TESTED, REJECTED, AND SENT

JESUS, FULL OF THE HOLY SPIRIT, IS LED INTO THE WILDERNESS AND TEMPTED BY THE DEVIL. HE RESISTS WITH SCRIPTURE, DISPLAYING PERFECT OBEDIENCE WHERE ADAM AND ISRAEL FAILED. HE RETURNS IN POWER, TEACHING WITH AUTHORITY. IN HIS HOMETOWN, HE IS REJECTED AFTER PROCLAIMING THAT ISAIAH'S PROPHECY IS FULFILLED IN HIM. BUT HIS MISSION PRESSES ON, BRINGING HEALING, DELIVERANCE, AND THE GOOD NEWS OF THE KINGDOM.

1. JESUS DEFEATS TEMPTATION WITH GOD'S WORD

JESUS OVERCOMES SATAN'S TEMPTATIONS IN THE WILDERNESS BY QUOTING SCRIPTURE (LUKE 4:1-13), SHOWING RELIANCE ON GOD'S WORD AS THE FOUNDATION FOR SPIRITUAL VICTORY.

- MEMORIZE SCRIPTURE TO RESIST TEMPTATION.
- TRUST GOD'S WORD IN PERSONAL TRIALS.
- TEACH OTHERS TO USE SCRIPTURE FOR SPIRITUAL STRENGTH.

CHAPTER 4 LUKE PLAN

2. REJECTION ACCOMPANIES GOD'S CALL

JESUS FACES REJECTION IN NAZARETH (LUKE 4:16-30), YET CONTINUES HIS MISSION, DEMONSTRATING THAT OPPOSITION OFTEN ACCOMPANIES GOD'S CALLING BUT DOES NOT THWART IT.

- PERSEVERE IN YOUR CALLING DESPITE OPPOSITION.
- SUPPORT OTHERS FACING REJECTION FOR THEIR FAITH.
- PRAY FOR RESILIENCE IN SHARING THE GOSPEL.

3. MIRACLES VALIDATE, PREACHING PREVAILS

JESUS' MIRACLES (E.G., HEALING, EXORCISMS; LUKE 4:31–41) CONFIRM HIS DIVINE AUTHORITY, BUT HE PRIORITIZES PREACHING THE KINGDOM OF GOD, EMPHASIZING HIS MISSION'S CORE.

- TRUST JESUS' AUTHORITY IN YOUR LIFE.
- FOCUS ON SHARING THE GOSPEL OVER SEEKING SIGNS.
- USE YOUR GIFTS TO POINT OTHERS TO CHRIST'S MESSAGE.

4. GOSPEL FOR OUTSIDERS AND OUTCASTS

JESUS EXTENDS GRACE TO GENTILES AND SOCIETAL OUTCASTS (LUKE 4:25–27), SHOWING THE GOSPEL TRANSCENDS CULTURAL AND SOCIAL BOUNDARIES, WELCOMING ALL.

- REACH OUT TO MARGINALIZED OR OVERLOOKED PEOPLE.
- SHARE THE GOSPEL WITH DIVERSE COMMUNITIES.
- REFLECT GOD'S INCLUSIVE LOVE IN YOUR ACTIONS.

CALLING THE UNLIKELY

1. JESUS' CALL ROOTED IN GRACE

JESUS CALLS UNLIKELY DISCIPLES LIKE SIMON PETER AND LEVI, NOT BASED ON THEIR MERIT BUT THROUGH GRACE (LUKE 5:1–11, 27–32), SHOWING HIS MISSION PRIORITIZES GOD'S UNEARNED FAVOR.

- TRUST GOD'S GRACE IN YOUR CALLING, DESPITE UNWORTHINESS.
- EXTEND GRACE TO OTHERS IN YOUR RELATIONSHIPS.

2. FORGIVENESS CENTRAL TO HIS MISSION

JESUS DINES WITH TAX COLLECTORS AND SINNERS (LUKE 5:29–32), DEFYING CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS NORMS TO SHOW THE GOSPEL INCLUDES ALL, REGARDLESS OF STATUS.

- BUILD RELATIONSHIPS WITH THOSE SOCIETY REJECTS.
- SHARE THE GOSPEL ACROSS CULTURAL OR SOCIAL DIVIDES.

4. NEW PARADIGM, NOT A PATCH

JESUS' TEACHING, LIKE NEW WINE IN NEW WINESKINS (LUKE 5:33–39), DEMANDS A NEW WAY OF LIFE, NOT MERE REFORMS TO OLD RELIGIOUS SYSTEMS.

- EMBRACE JESUS' TRANSFORMATIVE CALL IN YOUR FAITH.
- AVOID CLINGING TO OUTDATED TRADITIONS OVER CHRIST'S TRUTH.
- DISCIPLE OTHERS IN THE NEW LIFE JESUS OFFERS.

CHAPTER 6 LUKE PLAN

A NEW WAY OF LIVING

JESUS CHALLENGES THE PHARISEES OVER SABBATH PRACTICES AND ASSERTS HIS LORDSHIP. HE CHOOSES TWELVE APOSTLES AND TEACHES THE SERMON ON THE PLAIN, OFFERING BLESSINGS TO THE POOR AND WOES TO THE RICH. HIS WORDS TURN WORLDLY VALUES UPSIDE DOWN: LOVE YOUR ENEMIES, DO GOOD TO THOSE WHO HATE YOU, AND BUILD YOUR LIFE ON THE ROCK OF OBEDIENCE.

1. JESUS REDEFINES RIGHTEOUSNESS

JESUS PRIORITIZES MERCY, LOVE, AND JUSTICE OVER RIGID LEGALISM, AS SEEN IN HIS SABBATH ACTIONS AND TEACHINGS (LUKE 6:1–11, 27–36), REDEFINING RIGHTEOUSNESS AS COMPASSIONATE OBEDIENCE TO GOD.

- PRACTICE MERCY AND LOVE IN DAILY INTERACTIONS.
- PURSUE JUSTICE IN YOUR COMMUNITY, REFLECTING JESUS' VALUES.

2. BEATITUDES ELEVATE THE LOWLY

THE BEATITUDES (LUKE 6:20–26) BLESS THE POOR, HUNGRY, AND PERSECUTED WHILE WARNING THE RICH AND POWERFUL, SHOWING GOD'S KINGDOM UPLIFTS THE MARGINALIZED AND CHALLENGES WORLDLY STATUS.

- ADVOCATE FOR THE OPPRESSED AND MARGINALIZED.
- REFLECT ON PERSONAL RELIANCE ON GOD, NOT WORLDLY SECURITY.
- SHARE THE HOPE OF THE BEATITUDES WITH THE HURTING.

3. DISCIPLESHIP: GOOD FRUIT, TRANSFORMED HEART

TRUE DISCIPLES BEAR GOOD FRUIT THROUGH A TRANSFORMED HEART, NOT JUST WORDS OR APPEARANCES (LUKE 6:43–49), EMPHASIZING AUTHENTIC FAITH ROOTED IN OBEDIENCE TO JESUS' TEACHINGS.

- EXAMINE YOUR HEART FOR GENUINE FAITH AND ACTIONS.
- MENTOR OTHERS IN LIVING OUT CHRIST-CENTERED VALUES.
- BUILD YOUR LIFE ON JESUS' TEACHINGS AS A FIRM FOUNDATION.

FAITH THAT AMAZES

JOHN THE BAPTIST QUESTIONS JESUS FROM PRISON, AND JOHN'S **JESUS AFFIRMS ROLE** WHILE HIGHLIGHTING THE RESISTANCE OF THAT GENERATION. A SINFUL WOMAN ANOINTS JESUS' FEET, AND HE FORGIVES HER, SHOWING THAT LOVE FLOWS FROM KNOWING WE'VE BEEN FORGIVEN.

1. FAITH MEASURED BY TRUST, NOT PROXIMITY

THE CENTURION'S FAITH, DESPITE BEING A GENTILE OUTSIDER, IS PRAISED FOR ITS TRUST IN JESUS' AUTHORITY (LUKE 7:1–10), SHOWING FAITH IS ROOTED IN CONFIDENCE IN CHRIST, NOT PHYSICAL OR CULTURAL CLOSENESS.

- TRUST JESUS' POWER IN YOUR CHALLENGES, REGARDLESS OF CIRCUMSTANCES.
- ENCOURAGE OTHERS TO RELY ON CHRIST, NOT THEIR POSITION.
- SHARE STORIES OF FAITH WITH THOSE FEELING DISTANT FROM GOD.

POWER AND PRESENCE

- TRUST JESUS' POWER IN YOUR FEARS OR CRISES.
- SHARE TESTIMONIES OF GOD'S DELIVERANCE WITH OTHERS.
- PRAY FOR THOSE FACING OVERWHELMING CHALLENGES.

3. FAITH PURSUES JESUS IN CRISIS

THE BLEEDING WOMAN AND JAIRUS (LUKE 8:40–56) PURSUE JESUS AMIDST CROWDS AND CRISES, DEMONSTRATING PERSISTENT FAITH THAT SEEKS HIM DESPITE OBSTACLES.

2. HOLINESS FROM THE HEART

1. JESUS ENTERS SUFFERING WITH CLARITY

JESUS FACES HIS BETRAYAL AND CRUCIFIXION WITH RESOLUTE CLARITY (LUKE 22:14–23, 39–46), PRAYING IN GETHSEMANE AND SUBMITTING TO GOD'S WILL, MODELING STEADFAST OBEDIENCE IN SUFFERING.

- FACE TRIALS WITH PRAYERFUL RESOLVE, TRUSTING GOD'S PLAN.
- ENCOURAGE OTHERS TO SEEK GOD'S STRENGTH IN SUFFERING.

1. CROSS REVEALS SIN AND LOVE

THE CROSS EXPOSES HUMAN SIN THROUGH JESUS' UNJUST CRUCIFIXION (LUKE 23:1–25) WHILE DISPLAYING DIVINE LOVE AS HE WILLINGLY SUFFERS FOR HUMANITY'S REDEMPTION (LUKE 23:33–34).

2. JESUS' WILLING SACRIFICE

JESUS DIES NOT AS A HELPLESS VICTIM BUT AS A WILLING SACRIFICE, EMBRACING THE FATHER'S WILL (LUKE 23:46), DEMONSTRATING HIS SOVEREIGN CHOICE TO OFFER SALVATION.

- TRUST JESUS' INTENTIONAL SACRIFICE FOR YOUR SALVATION.
- MODEL SACRIFICIAL LOVE IN YOUR RELATIONSHIPS.
- TEACH OTHERS ABOUT JESUS' PURPOSEFUL DEATH.

3. KINGDOM FOR THE REPENTANT

THE REPENTANT THIEF'S SALVATION (LUKE 23:39–43) SHOWS JESUS' KINGDOM WELCOMES THOSE WHO TURN TO HIM, EVEN IN THEIR FINAL MOMENTS, HIGHLIGHTING THE POWER OF GRACE.

- REPENT AND TRUST JESUS FOR SALVATION AT ANY MOMENT.

- CELEBRATE GOD'S GRACE FOR THE REPENTANT.

RISEN AND REIGNING

RESURRECTION CHANGES EVERYTHING. THE JESUS RISES ON THE THIRD DAY, APPEARING TO WOMEN, TO TWO DISCIPLES ON THE ROAD TO EMMAUS, AND THEN TO THE ELEVEN. HE OPENS THEIR MINDS TO UNDERSTAND THE SCRIPTURES, SHOWING HOW EVERYTHING WRITTEN IN THE LAW, PROPHETS, AND PSALMS POINTED TO HIM. COMMISSIONS THEM TO **PREACH** REPENTANCE AND FORGIVENESS TO ALL NATIONS. THEN, HE BLESSES THEM AND ASCENDS TO HEAVEN.

1. RESURRECTION AFFIRMS JESUS' VICTORY

JESUS' RESURRECTION (LUKE 24:1–12) CONFIRMS HIS IDENTITY AS THE MESSIAH AND HIS TRIUMPH OVER DEATH, FULFILLING SCRIPTURE AND ESTABLISHING HOPE FOR ETERNAL LIFE.

- TRUST IN JESUS' RESURRECTION POWER FOR YOUR LIFE.
- SHARE THE HOPE OF THE RESURRECTION WITH OTHERS.
